A comprehensive review of the theory, the game mechanics used in various applications, and the objectives was given by Gupta and Gomathi. One of the

main advantages of such methods is providing students the ability to interact with the educational material, thus making the process more interesting and entertaining. Furthermore, gamification helps students in improving their thinking and allows for dynamic learning. Several studies have focused on the use of gamification in the learning process; however, very few studies focus on the use of gamification in the assessment process. The assessment process is important since it is the main tool for evaluating student performance. The nature of the assessment process may be a huge burden for students (see, for example, as they tend to feel that they have to memorize things and produce adequate answers within a limited amount of time, writing on paper in a way that is not required of them in their everyday activities. One important aspect of disengagement is the rigorous format of the examination process: students increasingly tend to think of it as a cause of their failure.

2. Teaching through conversations

Conversations are by far the most useful ways of teaching the language. When a child learns his or her mother tongue it is by the conversations that takes place between them and others or by listening to the conversations made by the others. The child is never taught the language but is still able to percept the meaning and learns it automatically to use it in day to day life. No one ever teaches the kid the characters of the language or how to make sentences or the grammar of that language. The conversations alone teach the children. Hence conversations form a very important part of the teaching process. The sentence construction and the grammar is not something that can be entirely taught by rules. The topic can be given to the students in form of written documents which they have to first read then form an opinion and then have a conversation about it or it can be spoken out and then they can listen, understand and also take part in the conversation.

3. Help from the multimedia

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Multimedia sources like songs, movies, TV series, magazines, newspapers play a very vital role in improving our language. Such sources can be used to help the students improve their language. But great precautions must be taken. 4. Spaced repetition

In language learning, the process of spaced repetition has been proven to be highly effective. Rather than repeatedly saying / studying a word 100 times in the same day, spacing repetition advocates argue that students learn more effectively if they repeat it 10 times a day for 10 days. Building on the best practice outlined above, some general hints and tips for using repetitive spacing follow below.
