The low level of English language skills of Indonesian people is related to education. In Indonesia, English is only learned in school but not used in daily life. That's why English in Indonesia in general taught as a foreign language. The term 'foreign language' in language teaching different from the 'second language'. A foreign language is an unspoken language as a means of communication in certain countries where the language is taught. While the second language is a language that is not the main language but is one of the languages the language used in general in a country.
